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Overflow your memories in a mini-album

Although tiny in size, Vicki Boutin's album overflows with memories. Learn how to make your by following the simple steps listed below.

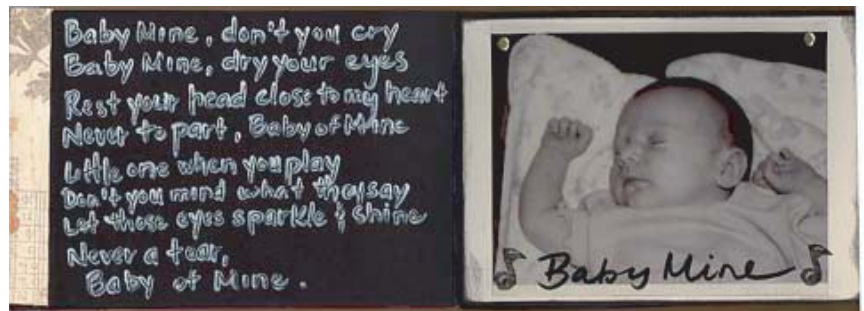


How to make the album

1. Cut two 6" x 4" pieces of cardboard and cover with pattern paper
2. Cut a piece of 12" x 12" cardstock into three 4" x 12" strips
3. Score each piece in the middle and attach three panels. (Vicki used 1" x 6" strips of patterned paper)
4. Adhere end pieces to covers and attach ribbon/fiber between ends and cover

How to decorate the pages

1. Create title by printing it as a mirror image on the shiny side of a transparency sheet and then rub it onto the cover
2. Rub a Versamark ink pad along the edges of the front cover and emboss with black embossing powder
3. Print photos (four 1/2" x 3 1/2" in size) on transparency sheets and mount on cream cardstock with brads
4. Write song title on card, mat and stamp with ScrapTivity music note, clear rubber stamps. Ink edges
5. Use a white Galaxy marker and black Zig pen for journaling
